#### 1.Parishioner's Question

1.1 There had been a request to discuss Planning Application 53/17/00002 for Power Poles Ltd. to store poles on Westonzoyland Airfield and as it was time-scaled the Chairman was minded to allow it even though it was not on the Agenda. The Company was being "evicted" from their site in Colley Lane, Bridgwater due to environmental health concerns. There followed a brief presentation by Mr. Hutchings outlining the potential damage to and dangers for both the local diary and crop growing farmers. A lively debate ensued which resulted in the Council agreeing to request that Sedgemoor regard Middlezoy Parish Council as a statutory consultee and that the Parish hold a special Planning Meeting to discuss the single item at which all parties should be present. Action: Clerk request that Middlezoy Parish Council be a consultee and that an extension to the deadline be granted and he would circulate dates for meeting in early March to Councillors.
