7.2 There were no payments to approve.

## 8. Planning Matters

Applications to be decided:

- 34/17/00002 Mrs E. Van-Zyl 16, Church Road. A discreet extension at the back of the
  property which Members felt would have no impact on neighbours or the street scene. All
  agreed to fully support and recommend approval.
- 34/17/00006 Mrs Slade at Main Road retirement bungalow which had been previously
  withdrawn. The Parish Council had supported the original bid and agreed to support this
  application as it would not affect neighbours or have a detrimental effect on the street
  scene. The Planning Officer felt the scheme too small but Middlezoy Councillors felt it
  adequate accommodation for a single retired person and would recommend approval.
- 34/17/00003 Messrs. Ridgment Leisure/Spa centre to complement holiday lodges. It was
  acknowledged that the holiday lets had contributed to increasing economic vitality in the
  village and this application would add another facet without detracting from existing
  businesses in the village. It would bring 6 jobs and was supported by the George Inn and
  Community Shop. It was resolved to support the bid for the above reasons and recommend
  approval.
- 34/17/00004 Mr N. Gillard Erection of building to form ancillary domestic accommodation.
- 34/17/00005 Mr N. Gillard Building to form farm office and rest room facility.
- 34/17/00001 Mr N. Gillard Erection of dwelling on site if agricultural building (to be demolished). These works are required to provide accommodation for full-time casual worker and seasonal worker to help farmer in pursuance of his expanding farming business. The Office/rest room for farm business to free up the farmhouse due to rowing family. The Councillors considered issues such as access and effect on neighbours and decided that it would be minimal. All in favour of supporting each of these applications. Action: Clerk respond accordingly on all above applications.
- 7, Hollies Close: appeal ongoing and Planning Inspector site visited that day.

## 9. Highways and Footpaths

- 9.1 The Chairman reported that the utilities to Smith's Farm development were re-connected but the ironworks of drains opposite junction were a hazard. Clllr. Gooda reported that Kick's Hill Lane was in a very poor state. The bottom of Holloway Lane at Main Road was flooding again. Action: Clerk report to SCC Highways.
- 9.2 Cllr. Laine reported that the junction of the A372 was already recognised as dangerous and was proving a major obstacle for mothers to access the play school. The Chairman had been advised that putting up a mirror (which he had) could result in personal liability so would not happen. The solution had to be considered long term and involve land purchase to improve this section of road.
